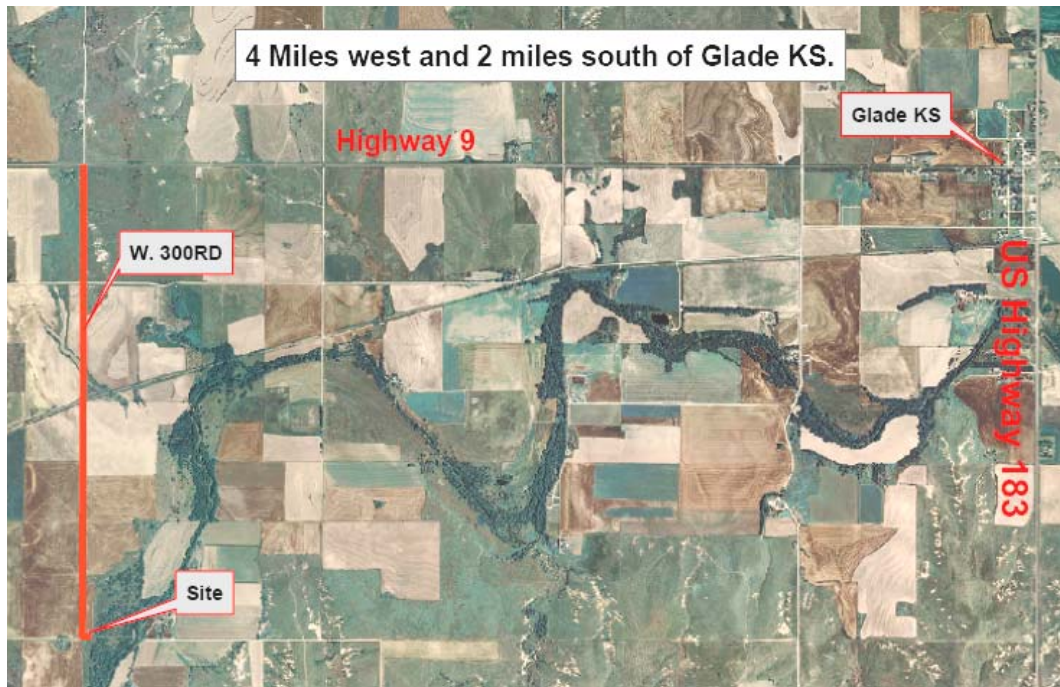


Water Quality/Locust Tree Control Field Day
